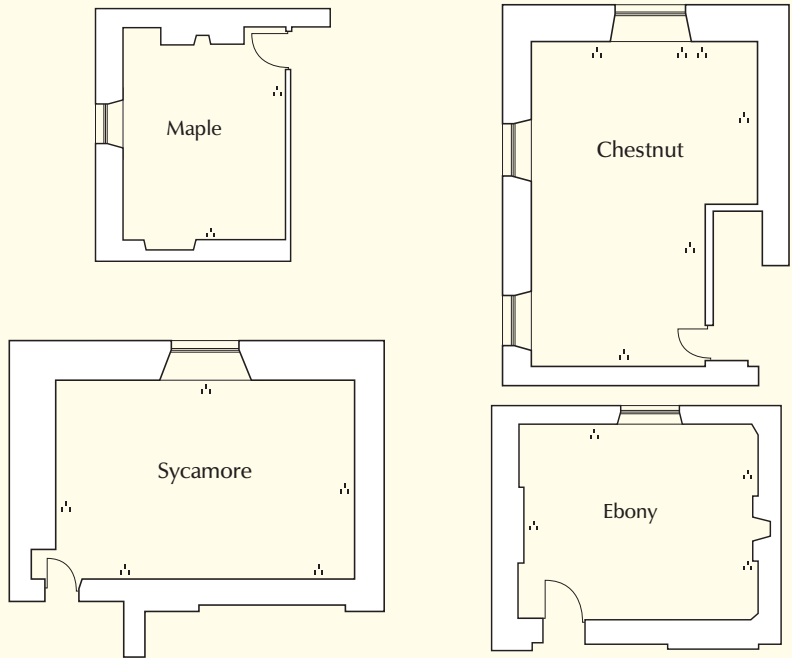

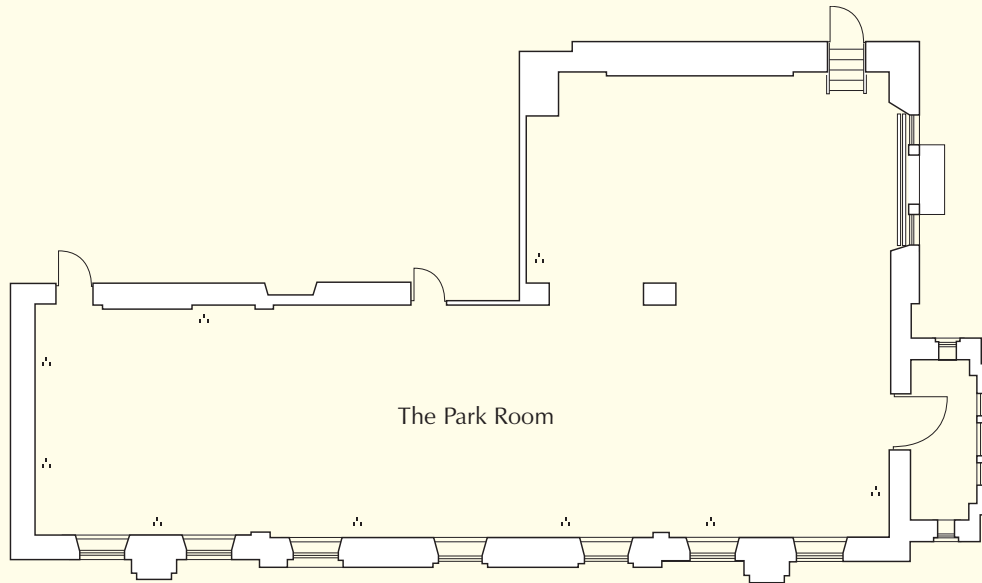

Golf in the Park

Both courses, The Crown and The Cromwell have their own distinctive character and are recognized as two of the finest in the South West.

Nestling in the heart of some of the most mature and unspoilt parkland the magnificent Crown Course is an easy walking course whilst presenting a challenge to all levels of player. This 6252 - yard par 69 course is rich in features with woodlands, lakes, inviting greens and well placed bunkers that require a 100% strategy.

The Cromwell Course is the perfect combination of old and new bringing together the best of both worlds. This course boasts a wonderful setting with mature trees, streams, lakes and modern USGA specification greens. Gentle undulating fairways provide this 6246 - yard par 71 course with excitement, reward and magnificent views stretching out across the Cotswold's.

Location and Communication



How to find us

The Park is easily accessible from all parts of the south west. From Junction 18 on the M4 we are situated 4 miles from Bath and 12 miles from Chippenham. The entrance to The Park is just off the A420 east of the village of Wick. From Bath take the Lansdown Road towards Wick, from Bristol take the A420 east towards Chippenham, from the M4 take junction 18, then the A46 towards Bath followed by the A420.

By Air

Bristol International Airport is 20 minutes away. Chauffeur driven transport can be arranged for you at a charge.

By Helicopter

Helicopter landing in the hotel grounds can be arranged by prior arrangement. Our helicopter co-ordinates are 512642 north and 22450 west.

By Rail

There is a regular service from Paddington London to Bath or Bristol. Both stations are located 20 minutes away from the hotel and taxis should be available at the stations.
